<p>Take a photo with a body of water (stream, pond, lake, etc.) in nature.</p> 	<p>Look for wild berries. Although they look edible, some may be poisonous and nasty. Let's leave them for other animals that do eat them.</p> 	<p>Find a winged seed and take a photo of you dropping it. You should see it swirl like a helicopter!</p> 
<p>Look for an evergreen. An evergreen is a plant that has leaves throughout the year and is always green.</p> 	<p>Take a picture of a cloud that you find interesting and let us know what it looks like.</p> 	<p>Balance at least 5 rocks and take a selfie.</p> 
<p>Look for a leaf with three points.</p> 	<p>Look for mushrooms.</p> 	<p>Find a bird feather.</p> 
<p>Look for a tiny bit of moss.</p> 	<p>Find a twig that looks like a "Y"</p> 	<p>Look for a spider web on the trail.</p>
