

## Fee Information

From its inception, the Healing Garden has recognized the difficult financial impact of a cancer diagnosis. We have a financial model that purposely provides free and low-cost care.

Below please find detailed information about our fees:

- **New Clients—FREE:**
  - Each new client will receive an intake assessment that involves creating a care plan.
  - Social work consultations are available as needed including assistance identifying outside resources such as grants, transportation, housing assistance, etc.
- **Support Groups—FREE:**
  - We offer a variety of support groups to serve all stages of living with cancer.
- **Programs—FREE:**
  - A variety of workshops including art, nutrition, education, exercise, meditation, and other programs of interest are offered on a seasonal basis.
- **Individual Bodywork---SLIDING SCALE (\$40-\$90):**
  - You choose where you pay on the scale based on what you can afford that day. We understand what you can afford may vary from appointment to appointment. Therapists do not accept tips.
- **Fund-A-Need (FAN) Scholarship Fund—SLIDING SCALE (\$5-\$40):**
  - For clients who have difficulty paying on the sliding scale mentioned above and meet certain financial eligibility requirements, the Healing Garden has a scholarship fund called Fund-A-Need (FAN) to provide payment to bodywork providers.
  - Available only when the Fund has a positive cash balance.
  - Clients are requested to pay \$5 minimum to an individual provider.
  - Eligible clients will be approved to receive funding through FAN for **no more than four (4)** bodywork sessions per month if in active treatment or within 6 months of active treatment or **no more than two (2)** bodywork sessions per month if post treatment.
  - Eligibility criteria can be discussed with the Director of Clinical Care.
